Teams engage in sporting activities (including Traditional Indigenous Games) which promote healthy lifestyles and wellbeing, provide opportunities for engagement in social activities and develop ongoing networks.

The Elders Olympics is an annual event, conducted successfully over several years.

## ABOUT VOLUNTEER TRAINING

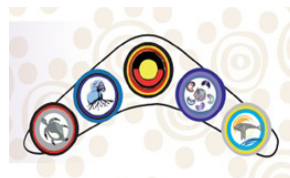
